Include in the notice your contact information and the proposed location. Staff will issue the proposal prescreening form and guidelines upon receipt of the letter of intent. The Prescreening form must be completed and submitted to [sps-conf-proposals@ieee.org](mailto:sps-conf-proposals@ieee.org) by **27 May 2016**. Proposal Prescreening Forms will be assessed by the Conference Board Executive Subcommittee. Accepted bidding teams [finalists] will be invited to present at the Conference Board meeting held at ICIP 2016, 25-28 September 2016 in Phoenix, Arizona, USA.
