

PROCEDURE FOR ICASSP AND ICIP PROPOSALS

Step 1: Read the “Annual Conferences” section of the Conference Organizers Handbook.

Step 2: Contact the Signal Processing Society Conference staff for more detailed instructions and guidelines.

Preliminary proposals should contain, at a minimum, the following: General Chair, Finance Chair, Technical Program chair, Local Arrangements Chair and a proposed venue. The proposal shall contain a preliminary budget, as well as a comparison to the registration fees for the last two conferences.

The relevant TC Chairs approve the Technical Program Chairs for the proposals.

The Conference Board may deviate from this schedule when necessary.
